INSTRUCTOR: SANDY HUFF**VIKING WEAVING**

Viking weaving is an ancient wire weaving technique for jewelry making and embellishment. History records Viking exploits dating back to the 9th century, with much being written about their invasion of lands. In fact, the term Viking is thought to derive from "Viking", a word for pirate in early Scandinavian language. The Viking people however are also known for their craftsmanship. Archeological discoveries have found beautifully crafted wire cording thought to have been worn as jewelry, as well as used for trade. This cording is frequently referred to as Viking weaving, netting, or knitting.

In this class you will learn the very SIMPLE traditional weaving technique used by the Vikings to create their decorative pieces. You will have the opportunity to either complete a length of cording in class or take it home to continue adding to its length. Tools needed are simple and few, however, if you decide to work on your cording at home you will need to return to the store at your convenience to use a "draw plate" necessary in completing your work.
